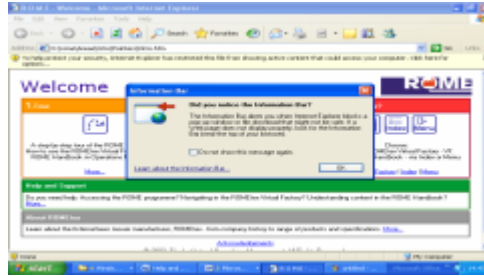
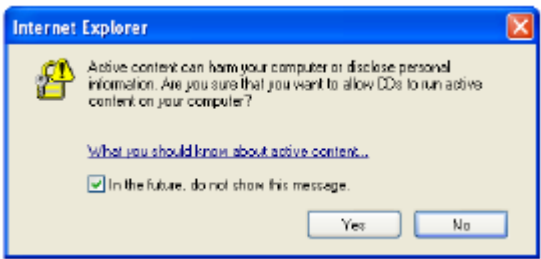


Microsoft perceived security violations

Since the ROME CD was first introduced there have been a number of updates to MS Windows and MS Internet Explorer, both in the terms of MS Service Packs (SP) and later versions of both MS Windows and MS Office.

As a result you may experience some difficulties with pop-up blockers and message bars. Most of these problems occur if you have installed Windows XP SP2, but will also appear if you are running MS Office 2003.

The problem becomes evident when you receive either of these two messages:



indicating that Internet Explorer has blocked active content.

It is tempting just to click on the options in the box and select Allow blocked content; but you will have to keep doing this.

To correct the problem:

Click on Start > Settings > Control Panel > Internet Options

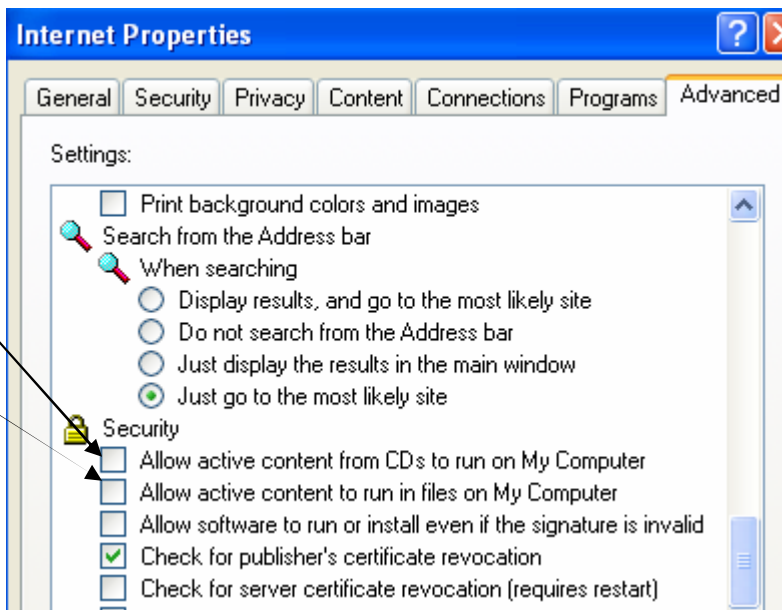
Select the **Advanced** tab at the top of the menu:

Scroll down to the **Security** heading

Tick the two boxes as shown below.

Then click on **Apply** at the bottom of the menu.

The software should then run OK.
